
How To Read Your Goucher College Billing Statement

1. Statement Date

This is the date the statement was created.

2. Goucher Student ID

This is the Student ID.

3. Previous Balance

This shows the credit balance or balance owed from the previous semester. If a credit, there's a negative in front (-\$999).

4. Due Date

This is the date the payment is due in full.

5. Total Amount Due

This is the amount to be paid on the due date and always includes the Previous Balance owed or the Previous Credit.

6. Important Information

This gives important information to be aware of, such as Health Insurance requirements, how to reach other offices for questions, etc.

7. Charge

This column shows your charges for the semester/term, including tuition, room, food plan, fees.

8. Credit

This column shows your Financial Aid, scholarships and grants, and payments.

9. Total Amount Due

This again shows the amount owed that is to be paid by the due date.

10. IF you see two asterisks ** by your Financial Aid

It means that it hasn't disbursed yet and is pending/anticipated.

On this sample, there are no asterisks, meaning that all Financial Aid on the statement has been disbursed. Financial Aid disbursal happens for most students in mid-September for the Fall semester and in mid-February for the Spring semester. If you think Aid is missing, you probably still need to complete something for disbursal and should check with the Financial Aid office.

11. Notice

If you waive Goucher's Health Insurance, the charge remains, but you'll see the credit line for the waiver below in the Credit section.
