The New Student Roadmap is your guide to the steps to complete prior to your arrival on campus. This process contains five steps; prior to each one, your student will receive an email that provides them with the information and links to the various steps to complete for each "stop".

New Student Roadmap

1 Academics

- Complete and submit the academic advising questionnaire.
- Sign and submit the financial responsibility document.
- Complete placement surveys or exams for foreign language or writing (if applicable to you).

2 Living on, or commuting to, campus

- Complete housing application. The housing application is sent from residentiallife@goucher.edu.
- Complete and submit health forms. Please have all forms completed and submitted by the day you move in to campus.
- Submit your selfie to selfie@goucher.edu.
- Register your car for parking.

3 Financial obligations

- Accept (or decline) any pending aid by logging into NetPartner.
- Confirm you have submitted all required documentation.
- Grant statement access through Goucher's e-billing page.
- Set up your refund preference with BankMobile to ensure any refunds due are processed immediately.
- Report all outside scholarships using the Outside Scholarships Form.
- Opt out of health insurance (if applicable).

4 Engage with campus life

- Complete new student surveys.
- Complete required online training modules prior to your arrival. Training modules and login information will be sent in an email to you.
- Read the summer read, *My Time Amongst the Whites*, by Jeannine Capo Cruet, and complete your essay.

5 Prepare for arrival!

- Review the Move-In website to see what to pack.
- Learn about having an on-campus job, and what paperwork you might need to bring with you to get signed up.
- Review the Fall Orientation schedule. Invite your family to attend Academic Convocation with you!
